

FQDN fully qualified domain name

A fully qualified domain name (FQDN) is the complete domain name for a specific computer, or host, on the Internet. The FQDN consists of two parts: the hostname and the domain name.

For example, an FQDN for a mail server might be `massimiliano.sbaraglia.com`.

The hostname is “massimiliano”, and the host is located within the domain “sbaraglia.com”.

Set a host name

```
hostname massimiliano
```

Set a ip domain name

```
ip domain-name sbaraglia.com
```
